Chinchilla Encouragement Campdraft **Conditions of Entry**

1. The Chinchilla Campdraft Committee reserves the right to alter or amend the program in any way whatsoever.
2. The committee reserves the right to refuse entries without any reason.
3. Horses to be nominated in order in which horses are to be ridden.
4. Campdraft competitors must hold themselves ready to compete at the advertised starting time on the day of draft. Three calls will be made for competitors. If the competitor fails to appear nomination fees paid or due shall be forfeited to Chinchilla Campdraft Committee.
5. Scratchings must be advised by 72 hours before the event or no refund unless a vet certificate is presented to the Secretary.
6. If a competitor nominates for the novice they cannot nominate for the encouragement.
7. Full nomination fees refunded only if competitors or horses are injured and if approved by the Chief Steward.
8. Any competitor who, in the opinion of the Chief Steward, deliberately mistreats or abuses stock will be disqualified from the event and also from participating in any further events on the program.
9. All competitors compete at own risk.
10. Time limit 40 seconds per round.
11. Nominations will be taken online through Campdraft Central (www.campdraftcentral.com.au) and will open Tuesday 14th February 2012 at 6.30am.
12. **Full nomination fees must be received by Friday 24th February 2012** via cheque or direct deposit.
13. All prize money listed is GST inclusive.
14. Refunds and prize money for novice, maiden and encouragement drafts will be paid out by direct deposit following the event. To receive payment promptly competitors are requested to ensure their current banking details are provided on Campdraft Central.
15. All competitors must present completed horse health declarations to the secretary's office on arrival at the event. These will be made available online the week prior to the event.
